



GUIDELINES FOR DECORATIVE FLAGS

1. Flags must be mounted on the house or structure attached to house with an appropriate flag holder.
2. The American flag may be flown at all times. Any other flag will need Architectural Review Board (ARB) approval to be flown at all times. No flag over the size of 3' x 5' will be allowed.
3. Flags may not be attached to flag poles or trees.
4. Flags must reflect either the season or be golfing related. For example: Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter, Christmas, Easter, Thanksgiving, etc. Special occasion flags such as birthdays or the birth of a baby, will be permitted for no more than two weeks.
5. Spirit flags that represent schools, clubs, teams or symbols of such, will only be permitted for three days.
6. One flag is permitted on the front and rear of each house.
7. Flags deemed by the Modification Committee or the Board of Directors to be "in poor taste" or tattered will not be permitted. Oversized flags will not be permitted.
8. If existing flags do not comply with these guidelines, the owner will be notified and expected to comply or remove their flag.
